St. Marys Community Pool Policies

The St. Marys Community Pool has the authority to close the Community Pool for the following reasons:

- 1. The outside temperature is below 70 degrees.
- 2. The pool will close at 2:00PM if there are no patrons within the first hour of opening. It will then reopen at 4:30PM.
- 3. The pool will close at 5:30PM if there are no patrons within the first hour of the second shift. It will then reopen the following day, weather permitting.
- 4. Any maintenance issues related to the pool, and if it is having effects on the patrons there.
- 5. At the first sound of thunder or sight of lightning, swimming will cease. The pool will then open for swimming an hour after the last sound of thunder or sight of lightning. Patrons are permitted to wait out the storm.
- 6. If the main drain is not visible from the nearest lifeguard chair due to heavy rainfall.
- 7. There will be no refunds for non-members due to weather closures.
- 8. If the pool closes due to a maintenance issue, refunds will be given to non-members in the form of a "free pass".
- 9. All non-members will be provided a bracelet at the time of payment. Non-members must be wearing the bracelet on their wrist to be given a "free pass" and/or re-entry to the swimming pool.
- 10. Non-members who are not wearing the bracelet on their wrist will not be permitted re-entry to the pool and must pay for admission.

Some swimming lessons will be held during the open times of the pool. Please be advised that certain sections of the pool may be closed while swimming lessons are taking place.

The maximum class size for EACH level is 10 students.

For levels PK, 1, 2, and 3 there will be 1 instructor for every 5 students signed up.

For levels 4 and 5/6 there will be 1 instructor for every 10 students signed up.

We will not be holding private lessons.

All students are encouraged to get into the water. If a student does not want to, then he or she will be permitted to sit on the sidelines and watch their peers. Parents will not be permitted to be with their child during swimming lessons at any time. If a child exhibits negative behavior that affects others participating in lessons, the child may be asked to leave.

Lessons are held rain or shine. Please have your child pack warmer clothes for colder days as we will still be teaching them water safety. *LESSONS ARE HELD EVEN IF THE POOL IS CLOSED FOR THE DAY.*



The first seven days are instruction based (in water or water safety depending on weather). The eighth day is a "Test Day" where students will perform all skills based on the American Red Cross test. The ninth day is a "Fun Day" where students will play games and celebrate their achievements! At the end of test day, students will be given a report card along with notes for what to practice for the next season. On this report card is where you will see if your child should or should not advance to the next level.

It is the parent's responsibility to show up for lessons---we will not be sending out reminders. There are no refunds for swimming lessons under any circumstance.
