 WHERE CHILDREN CAN LEARN ABOUT THEMSELVES, BUILD SELF-WORTH, AND
 EXPERIENCE SUCCESS.
- FOSTER RELATIONSHIPS AMONG PARTICIPANTS AND STAFF THAT HELP FORM FRIENDSHIPS.
- ENCOURAGE INDEPENDENCE AND GOOD CHOICE-MAKING SKILLS.
- PROMOTE GOOD COMMUNICATION SKILLS.
- DEVELOP ACTIVE LISTENING SKILLS.
- SUPPORT A HEALTHY RESPECT FOR DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION.
- PROVIDE AN INFORMAL, PEACEFUL, AND COMMUNITY-ORIENTED ENVIRONMENT WHERE CHILDREN CAN EXPERIENCE DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES THAT HELP THEM LEARN ABOUT THEMSELVES.

PARENT/GUARDIAN INVOLVEMENT

- IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN TO ENSURE THE CHILD'S ONLINE ACCOUNT IS UP TO DATE, INCLUDING EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION.
- IT IS THE RESPONSBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN TO KNOW WHAT PROGRAM(S) THE CHILD IS SIGNED UP FOR. WE WILL NOT SEND OUT REMINDERS.
 PARENTS CAN LOOK AT THE CHILD'S SCHEDULE ON THEIR RECDESK ACCOUNT.

PROGRAM POLICIES

1. ENROLLMENT/REGISTRATION

- a. Online enrollment/registration is the fastest and most guarenteed way of securing your child's spot.
- b. Enrollment for each program ends at least 1 week prior to the scheduled program.
- c. Enrollment for summer programs is open online at STMARYS.REDESK.COM:
 - i. ST. MARYS RESIDENTS: APRIL 7, 2025 6AM
 - ii. NON-RESIDENTS: APRIL 14, 2025 6AM
- d. All programs and events (except Kickoff to Summer Bash) are setup for the INCOMING GRADE LEVEL FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR (2025-2026).

2. SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT

- a. A parent/guardian is required to sign the child in and out of camp each day. If your child is leaving early for an appointment, won't be there for a day, or is being picked up by someone other than yourself, please inform a staff member at drop-off.
- b. If a child is permitted to walk or ride his/her bike home, they may sign themselves in or out. A written note needs presented to a staff member.
- c. If your child will be dropped off late, it is important that you find a staff member on park property to sign them in. Please DO NOT drop your child off without signing in and meeting with a staff member.
- d. If your child is not going to be present at camp, please email us at rec@stmaryspa.gov

3. REFUNDS

- a. Refunds are available to those who cancel their registration NO LESS THAN 1 WEEK PRIOR TO THE START OF THE PROGRAM. There will be no exceptions.
- b. All refund requests must be made via email to rec@stmaryspa.gov . Please include the participant's name and what camp/program you are cancelling for.
- c. Refunds will be granted in full if the program is cancelled by the department (normally if a minimum requirement is not met for the program--less the 3% CC fee).
- d. Refunds will be made via original payment method (less the 3% CC fee).

PROGRAM POLICIES

1. MEDICATION

a. Staff is not permitted to administer any type of medication.

2. **ELECTRONIC AND PAPER MEDIA**

a. By registering your child for participation in any of the department programs, you consent to and authorize the use and reproduction by the City of St. Marys any photographs and audio-visuals taken of your child for marketing materials.

3. POTTY TRAINING

a. Children participating in any COSMPR program must be **FULLY** potty-trained, no exceptions.

4. FIELD TRIPS

a. Parents will be asked to sign one permission silp at the start of the camp session. This permission slip will cover all trips that will take place during that session. Dates, destinations, and times can be found online at stmarys.recdesk.com under the camp in which you registered for.

PROGRAM POLICIES

1. LOST AND FOUND

a. Each park has a lost and found--please check frequently, as our totes pile up QUICKLY. All items not claimed by August 1 will be donated to the St. Marys Resale Shop.

2. REQUEST TO KEEP PARTICIPANTS SEPARATED

a. We cannot accomodate any request by a parent/guardian to keep specific children separated during our program. Focusing so much of our Activity Leader's attention on managing or keeping children separated greatly restricts their ability to provide quality care for the remaining participants.

3. BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT

a. Behavior problems are managed through conflict-resolution techniques such as leader/child discussion, redirection, offering of choices, removal from situation, loss of privileges, and in severe situations, dismissal from the program. The department reserves the right to dismiss a child from a program if a child cannot adjust to the program setting and behave appropriately.

4. HEALTH & WELLNESS

a. Children who are sick will not be permitted to attend camp. If your child becomes ill at camp, parents/guardians will be notified and expected pick their child up in a timely manner.

5. WAITLIST

a. Programs are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. In the event a spot opens, we will look to see who the next person in line is on the waitlist. You will be contacted via phone for information on this opening. If we do not hear back from you within 1 day, we will move to the next person.

6. WEATHER EMERGENCIES

a. Our programs our held rain or shine. During rainy weather, we move children indoors to the facility onsite. However, if the forecast is calling for severe weather, we may inform you to pickup your child.

WHAT TO BRING/WEAR:

- Each child is required to bring a packed lunch, drink, and snack each day to camp. Refrigeration and microwaves are not available for camp kids. Please refrain from packing anything with peanuts or peanut butter due to allergies of staff and other participants. (EXCEPT KICKOFF TO SUMMER BASH OR DELGROSSO'S DEPENDING ON IF YOUR CHILD BUYS THEIR LUNCH) PLEASE CHECK RECDESK FOR COMPLETE INFORMATION!
- An additional water bottle--different from lunch. Please send a reusable water bottle with your child's name on it every day.
- Extra set of clothes--kids get dirty!
- Swim suit/towel/sunscreen--we love to take advantage of water games if the weather is right!
- Please send your child dressed appropriately and comfortably, ready for warm or cold, rain or shine! We ask that children have closed toed shoes to allow full participation.
- Backpack for their things-labeled with their name.

What to NOT Bring/Wear:

- Please leave all electronic devices at home. If a child needs a cell phone, they will be permitted to keep it in their backpack on silent.
- Do not send money with your child.
- If your child is not willing to share something, please leave it at home--if they don't absolutely need it, please don't send it!:)
