**SUMMARY OF POSITION:** Under close supervision of the Aquatics Supervisor and Head Lifeguard, monitors activities in the water and ancillary areas of aquatic facilities to ensure the safety of patrons; learns, explains, and enforces safe swimming programs and pool policies, regulations, and rules. Performs rescues and administers first aid, CPR, and AED as needed.

# **Essential Functions:**

- □ Performs all lifeguard responsibilities including monitoring pool activities, applying first aid, and performing water rescues as necessary.
- Ensures that swimmers are well supervised. Fills in as a regular lifeguard as necessary.
- Implements and monitors policies and procedures; enforces aquatic regulations; cautions patrons regarding unsafe activities
- □ Assists and aids in swim lesson programs under the direction of the Aquatics Supervisor and Head Lifeguard
- Provides high quality customer service in a safe and timely manner.
- □ Inspects and maintains swimming and pool equipment for functionality, ensures proper placement and availability in the pool area, and recommends maintenance and repair as needed.
- □ Maintains pool and restroom areas in a safe and clean condition
- □ Maintains logs and records of all activities/swim lessons/injuries
- Participates in required training sessions, including safety drills, and other emergency procedures.
- □ Assists with special events as needed.
- Contributes to the team effort by performing other duties as needed or directed by the Aquatics Supervisor and Head Lifeguard.

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILL, AND ABILITY REQUIREMENTS:

#### Education and/or Experience:

- □ Must be at least 15 years old
- □ Knowledge of the principles and techniques of lifeguarding, including lifesaving methods and procedures.
- □ Operational characteristics of water rescue safety equipment and devices.

#### Necessary knowledge, skills and abilities:

- □ Ability to learn and understand the organization and operation of the aquatic facilities.
- □ Learn, monitor, and enforce all regulations, policies, and procedures.
- □ React to and handle swimmer rescue and medical emergencies in a safe and effective manner.
- □ Administer first aid, CPR, and AED as needed.

## Special Requirements:

□ Must possess American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification

- □ Must be willing to work mornings, mid-day, evenings, weekends, and some holidays.
- Current Pennsylvania State Police Criminal History report, Child Abuse History Clearance from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services, and a fingerprint based federal criminal history submitted through the Pennsylvania State Police or its authorized agent (FBI).
